

Registering for Summer Camps at Learning Outside

Online registration for summer camps goes live at 2:00PM on February 1st. Families visiting our site prior to 2:00PM on February 1st will need to refresh the page at, or after, 2:00PM to access the registration link.

Families must complete a **separate** registration form for each child they wish to enroll.

Children are **not** registered unless and until families receive an email from Learning Outside confirming their child's registration. We work hard to get those out to families as soon as possible.

Our site should not process a family's registration form if a camp no longer has openings. If our site does not let you submit your form, this means that one or all of the camps you are attempting to register for has filled. If this happens, please refresh your page to know which camps are still available.

If a camp you were hoping to register your child for is full, and you wish to be added to our waitlist, please contact shelby@learningoutside.org with the name of the camp(s) you are interested in and your child's name and age.

Currently-enrolled Learning Outside school-year families are given priority registration in advance of February 1st. In addition, in keeping with our mission, a minimum of 35% of Learning Outside's summer camp openings are held for children referred to us by local public schools for scholarships.

There are no refunds for withdrawals from any of Learning Outside's summer camps. In the event a family's plans change and a child is no longer able to attend camp, we do our best to fill that child's spot with a child from our waitlist. ***If*** we are able to do so, a refund *less a \$50 administrative fee* will be issued.

Each registration form includes an option for families to "Round Up." This is a wonderful way for families to support Learning Outside and the many programs we offer children in our community.
